All around the town.

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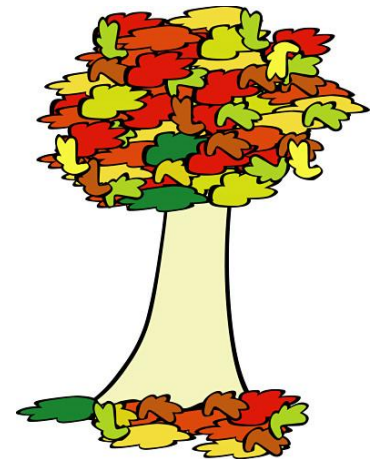
The leaves on the trees come tumbling down,

## An Autumn activity - Fun with leaves



This Autumn why not go out for a walk in the local woods or park and see how many Autumn leaves and seeds you can collect. You can then have lots of fun with your child once you get back home by doing the activities below or others that you can think of.

### Some ideas could include:

Leaf printing - set out different Autumn leaf colours of paint (orange, red, yellow, brown). The children paint the back of the leaves (where the veins can be felt the best) with a paint brush and one or more of the colours of paint. The children then carefully lay the leaves on a piece of white paper and tap them gently with their fingers. Remove the leaves from the paper to view the prints they have made.

An Autumn Collage - when you are out on your walk, collect leaves, acorns, sycamore seeds, twigs, etc. You might need to leave them for a little while to dry. Once ready, the children should put some glue on paper. They should then place the items they've collected onto the paper. Let the collage dry.

Whilst you are out collecting leaves and colouring in the squirrel picture provided, you can add to the fun by singing some Autumn songs. Two of our favourite songs are:
