A Christmas Activity

Most children love helping out in the kitchen so why not get them to help make a healthy and delicious treat that all the family can enjoy. Always make sure that your child is supervised in the kitchen and do not allow them to use sharp knives or anything else that might cause injury.

Christmas mixed fruit krispy cakes

Makes about 30 small cakes

50g (2oz) dried apricots (cut up into small pieces)

40g (1 $\frac{1}{2}$) oz rice krispies or similar

75g (3oz) dried cranberries

75g (3oz) dried raisins

1 tablespoon syrup

50g (2oz) caster sugar

50g (2oz) butter

Paper cake cases



1. Place all the dried fruit and rice krispies into a bowl. Mix together.
2. Put the syrup, sugar and butter into a saucepan. Heat gently on a low heat until everything has melted. Turn up to a medium heat and cook for 2 minutes. Then remove from the heat.
3. Leave the syrup mixture to cool for 5 minutes, and then pour over the rice krispies and fruit mixture.
4. Stir, and then put a spoonful of the mixture in each cake case.
5. Place all cakes into the fridge for about an hour until they have set.
