## Winter Activities

Here's another opportunity to get the children involved in some cooking. Once again they will be making some treats that the whole family can enjoy. Always make sure that your child is supervised in the kitchen and do not allow them to use sharp knives or anything else that might cause injury.

### Popcorn snowballs - To make 16 snowballs

50g Popcorn (unsalted and unsweetened)

200g Marshmallows

50g Butter

Cake Cases



### Method

If using popcorn kernels pop the popcorn. Melt the butter and marshmallows. When the butter and marshmallows are melted pour the mixture over the popcorn and mix well.

After the mixture has cooled, let the children take a handful of the mixture, and shape it into a ball and place into cake cases.
